S T A T E M E N T

13 June 1944

I was flying ship 031 as waist gunner, on the 12th of June 1944 on a combat operational mission over France, when a call came over the interphone that a ship had been knocked down. It came past my right waist window. I could see it didn't have any cockpit on it. It was blown off at the bulkhead between the navigator's compartment and the cockpit. It fell about 2000 feet, and then a fire spread slowly over the wings. I watched it go down, and saw two (2) chutes come out. It went behind a cloud out of sight at about 2000 feet. I didn't see it crash, but saw it burning on the ground after we had finished our bomb run.

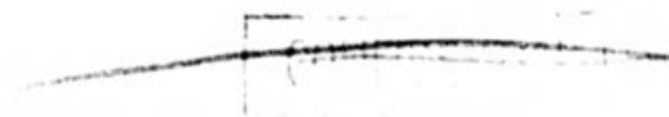

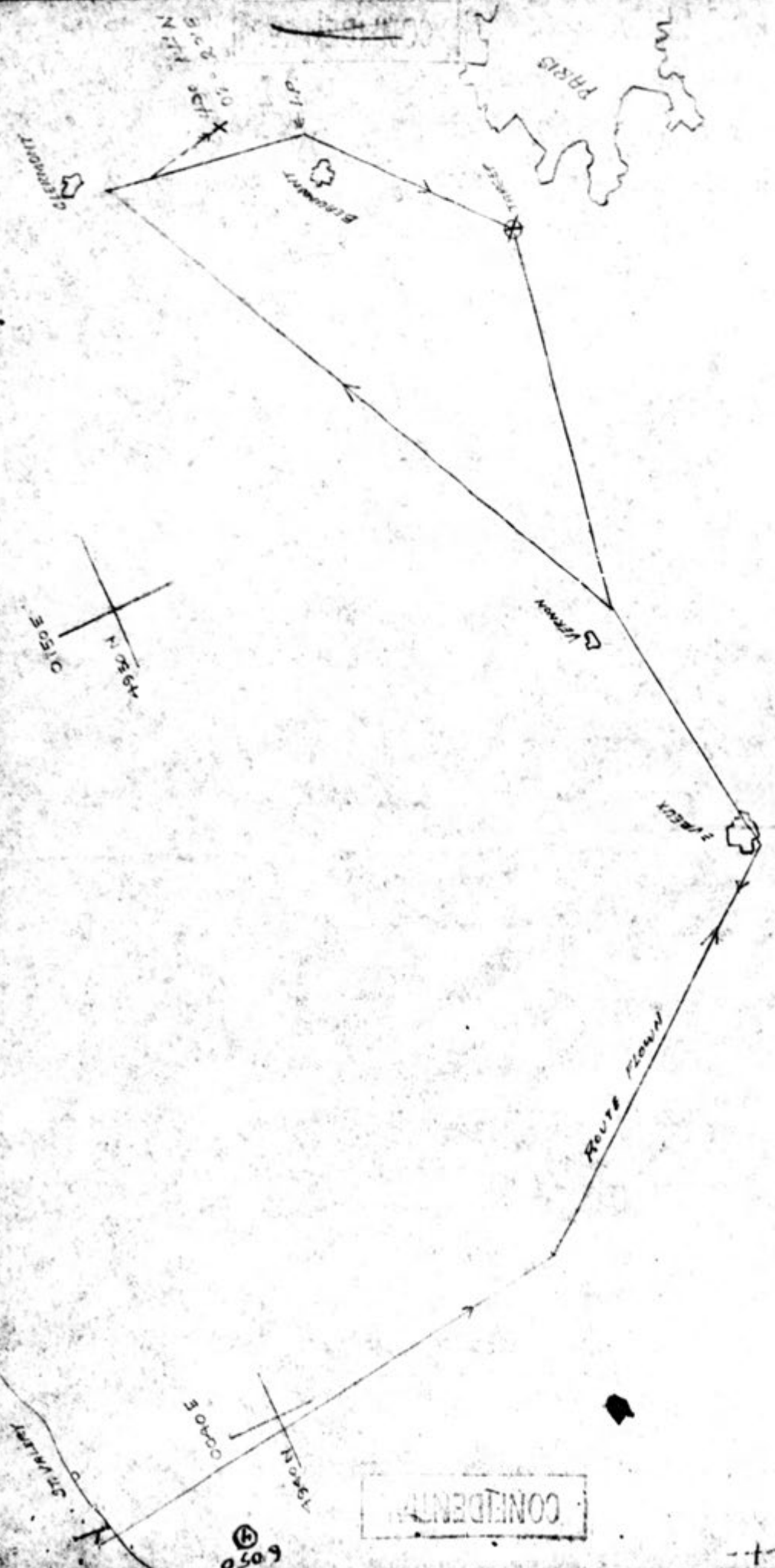
STATEMENT

13 June 1944

I saw Lt Kirby's ship fall out of formation. The nose section was blown off from the leading edge of the wing on the under side of the fuselage; on the top of the fuselage, it was blown off back to the generator panel. Both engines were missing. The ship dropped approximately 300 or 400 feet when two (2) parachutes were seen to open. The ship then dropped through the clouds and I lost sight of it.
